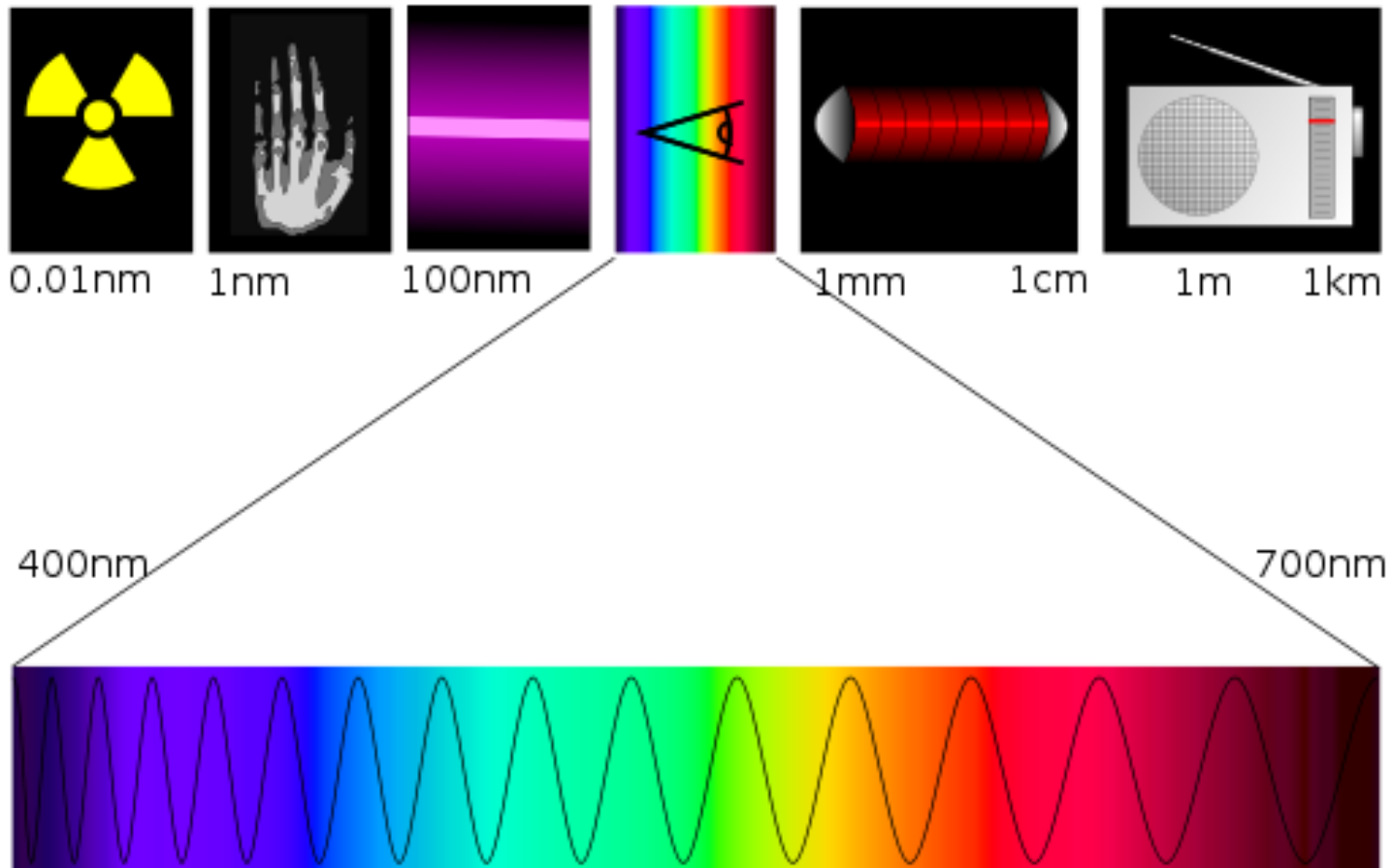

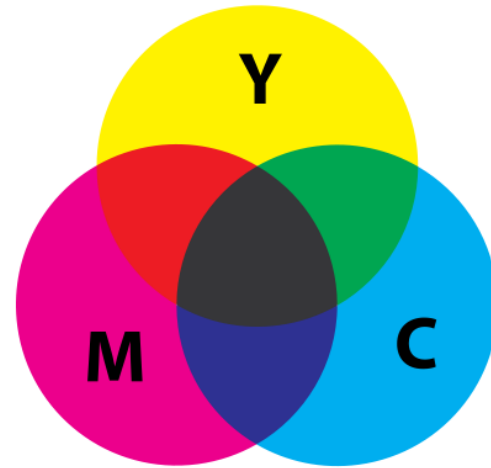

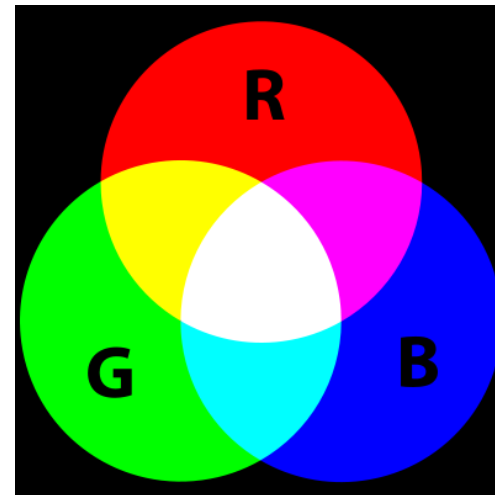
- Subtractive color mixing

➤ LIGHT! →



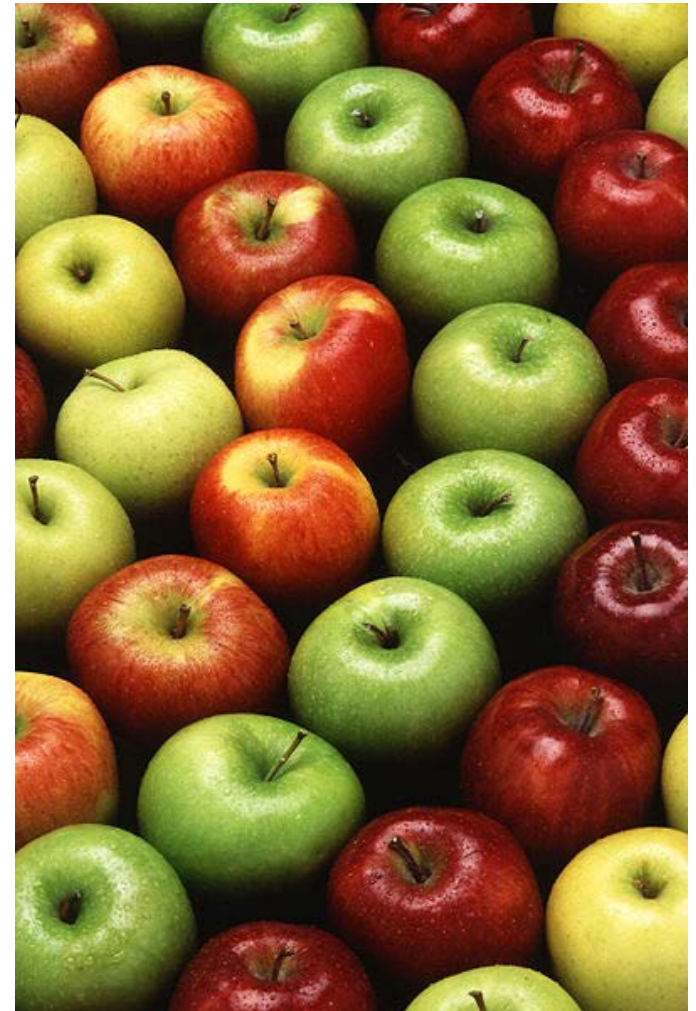
Light Source Technology

Did you know? Sunlight has all colors of the rainbow and appears WHITE



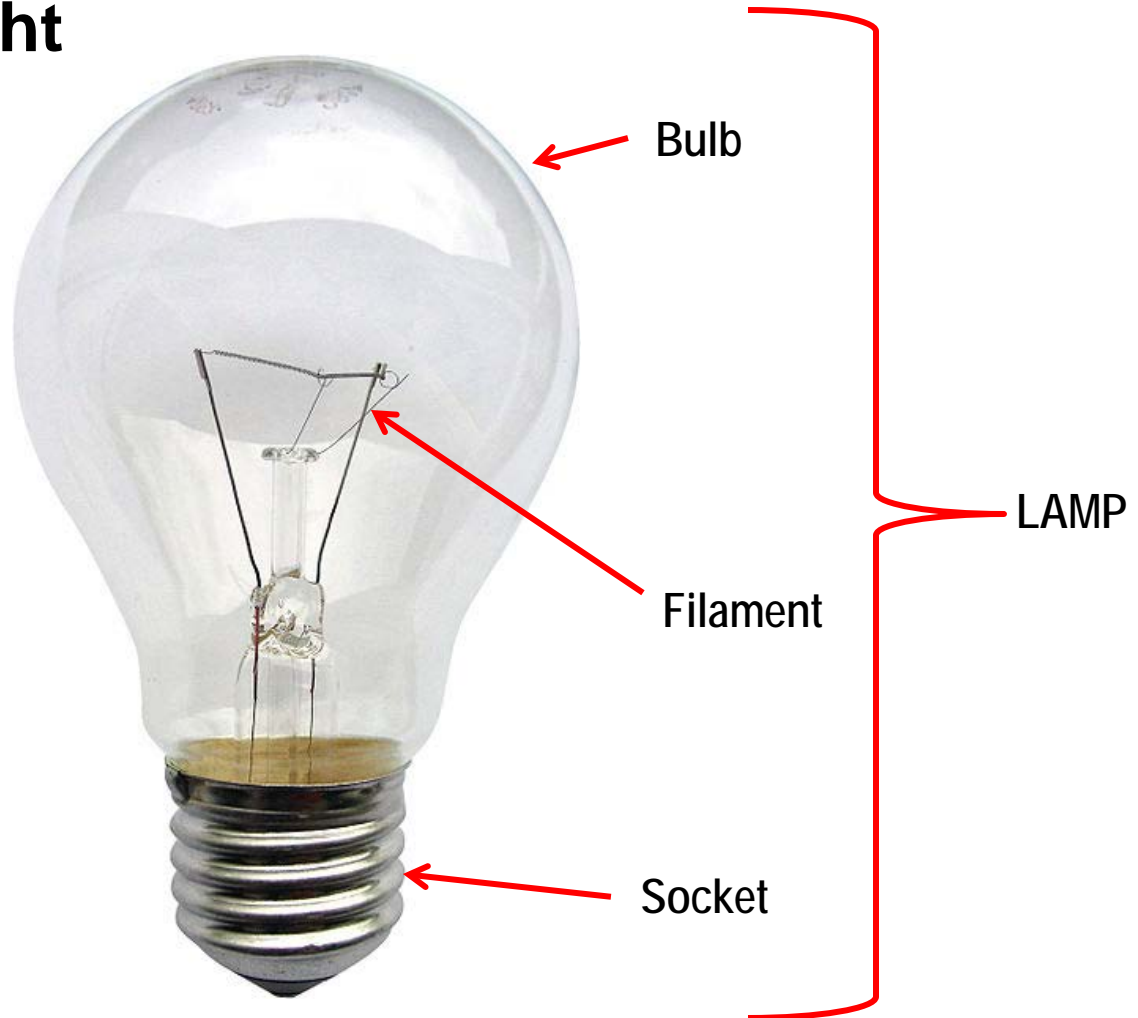
Visible Light

- Reflected light is what we “**SEE**”
- The **RED** apple is red because it absorbs all light except **RED**
- The **GREEN** apple is green because it absorbs all light except **GREEN**



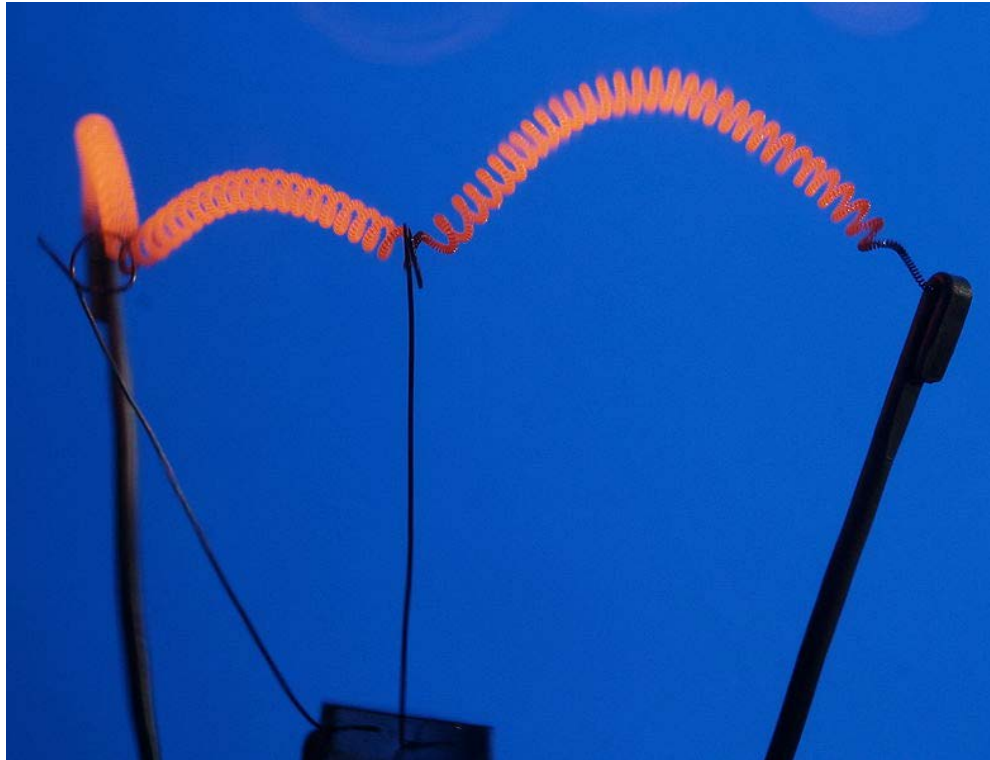

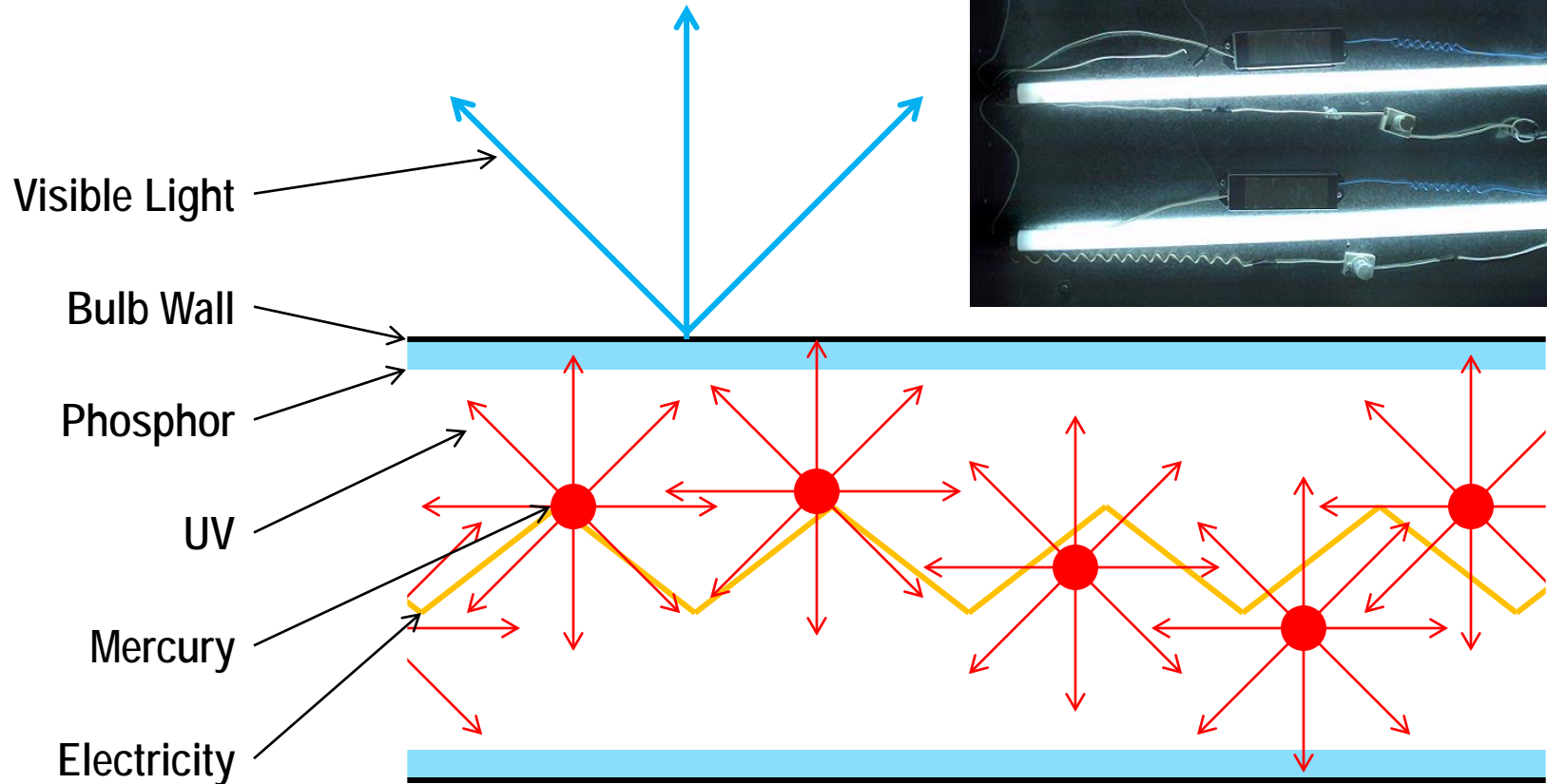

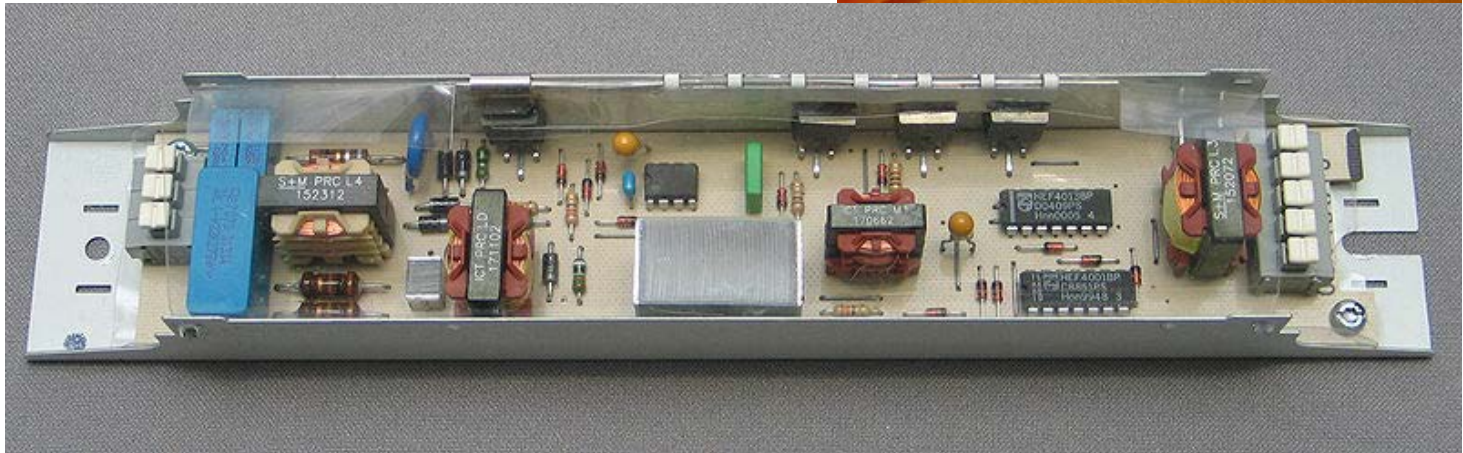

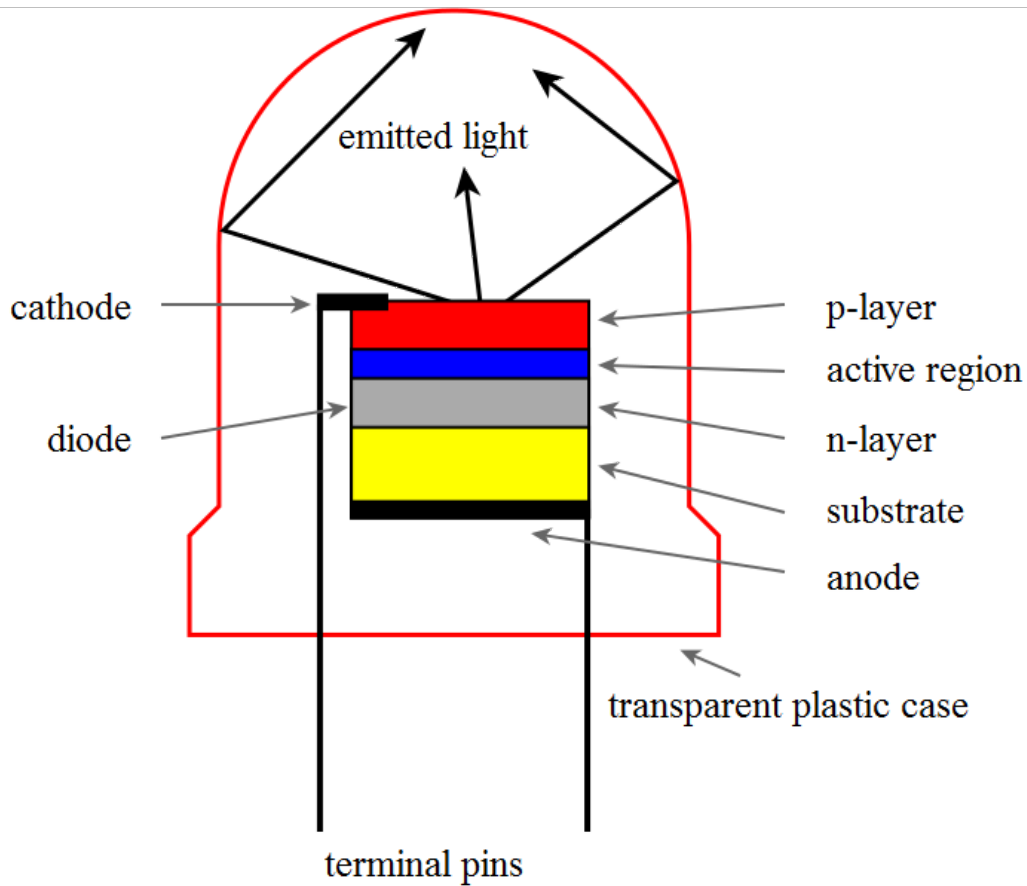

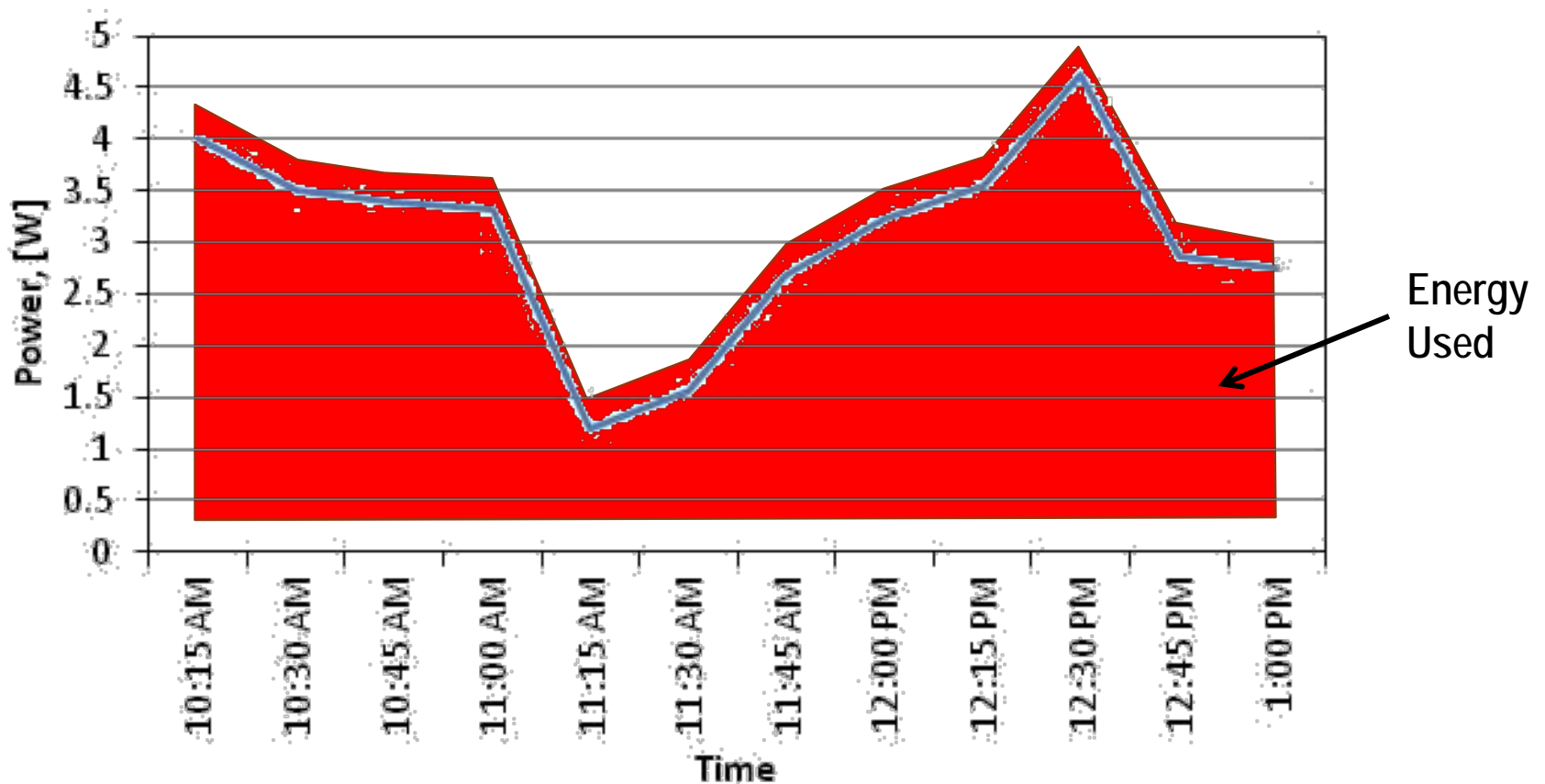

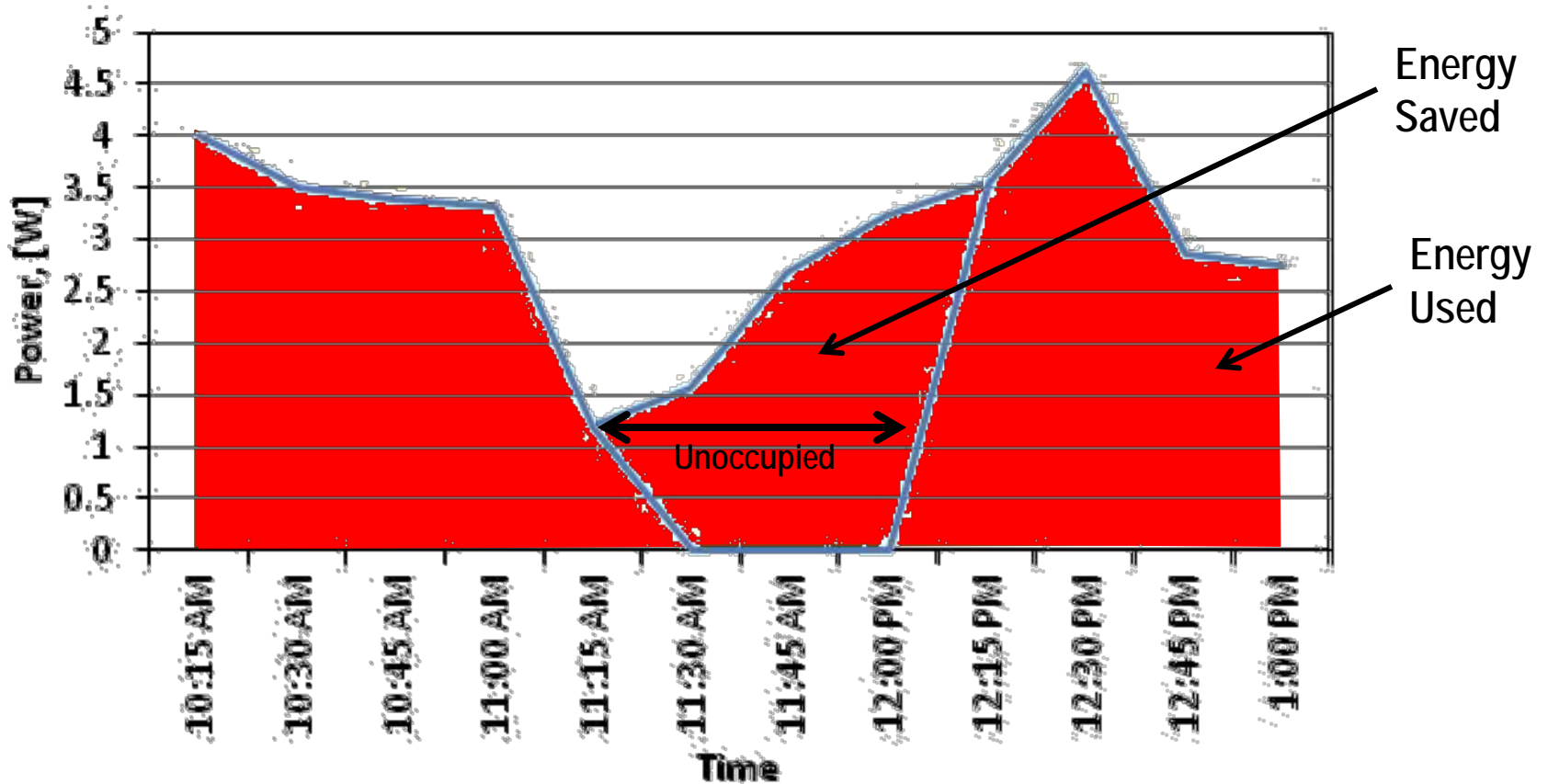
