



An ideal model of a simple gravity pendulum.

A “massive bob” suspended by a “massless rod” from a “frictionless pivot,” without air friction. When given an initial impulse, it oscillates at constant amplitude (Θ , theta), forever.

The “equilibrium position,” hanging perfectly vertically, is indicated in dashed lines.
